

B/BI/3 Alfred J Jones, Builder and Wheelwright, Erwood Acc 1817

Alfred Jones was the great grandson of William Morgan of Gwenddwr, builder, and the grandson of David Morgan, who built Bridge House, just outside Erwood, in 1875. A general store was run from the front room of the house, which sold groceries, cigarettes and tobacco; paraffin was also sold as well as meal (for poultry or pigs).
