R.U. Sayce came from Welshpool. He fought in France during the First World War, and was wounded. On his return he gained his M.A. from Aberystwyth. From 1921 to 1927 he was professor and head of the Department of Geography and Geology at the University College of Natal, South Africa. From 1927 to 1935 he was university lecturer in physical anthropology and material culture at Cambridge University. From 1935 to 1957 he was Keeper of the Victoria Museum at Manchester University. R.U. Sayce became a member of the Powysland Club in 1920, and edited its journal the Montgomeryshire Collections between 1930 and 1966. He was also elected to the council of the Royal Anthropological Institute of Great Britain and was editor of its Journal.
