The builder's notice on the scaffolding reads: 'Bradney & Lloyd, Builders, Contractors, Shifnal'. Kelly's Directory of 1895 has an entry for: Bradney & Lloyd, Albrighton, Wolverhampton & New Street, Shifnal. In the Shifnal section, they are listed as "Bradney & Lloyd, builders, contractors, plumbers & decorators, New Street."

The building is thought to be the Pump House Hotel, Llandrindod Wells, which was certainly extended in the 1870s, though this photograph must date from later, since Thomas Roberts was active in the 1890s.
